- We seek to be accommodating to accessibility needs. If you would like to have closed captions turned on during a workshop, private message the facilitator at the beginning of the session.
- If you need to leave a workshop early or may be in and out, please let the facilitator know in a private message at the beginning of the session.
- We value everyone's focus in our community. Your microphone should be muted unless you are speaking.
- We value everyone's presence in our community. The default should be for Zoom video to be on unless you have a reason it can't be (which you are entitled to keep private).
- Respect the scenario that the facilitator has created for the workshop, i.e., the range of topics, questions, format, and pacing. If you discover that you would like to pursue a question in greater depth, you may reach out to the facilitator--or your cabin members!--to continue the conversation in the direction you would like to go.
- Respect the time of the other participants to ensure that everyone has an opportunity to contribute if they would like to. Listen carefully and avoid interrupting.
- Speak from experience when answering questions.
- Invest extra effort in being friendly and sociable, given the fact that it's hard to read body language and facial expressions over Zoom.
